BUA 433: Multinational Business Finance

This course is designed to teach finance principles and applications from a deeper level than just the basic course. These concepts and tools are needed to handle complex problems to maximize a firm's value through value creation from global perspective. Students learn how to become effective managers by analyzing financial statements, cash flows, cost of capital, capital budgeting, capital structure, corporate valuation, and with exposure to global financial management.
