

COM 495: Professional Internship

Internships are directed learning in a professional work environment related to the communications field. Limited to Communications majors and minors. COM 495/496 internships must be performed with off-campus businesses or organizations. Internships with activities or offices affiliated with Newberry College, or performed in conjunction with activities for other courses, will not count for course credit. The business or organization is subject to verification and approval by Communications faculty. A minimum of 45 hours of on-site work is required for each hour of credit. Students are responsible for the completion and submission of the required Internship Application by posted deadline. All applications are subject to review and approval by Communications faculty.
