

# Graduate Admissions Criteria

Minimal Graduate Admissions criteria include:

- an earned bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university (as recognized by the Council for Higher Education)
- cumulative undergraduate GPA of (a) 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale, or (b) 3.0 or higher during the final 60 hours of undergraduate coursework. The GPA requirement is waived for applicants with a GPA of 3.0 or higher for an earned graduate degree.
  - applicants with a lower GPA may be reviewed for admissions consideration by the Dean of Online and Graduate Programs and the graduate program coordinator.
